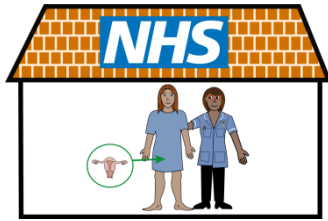
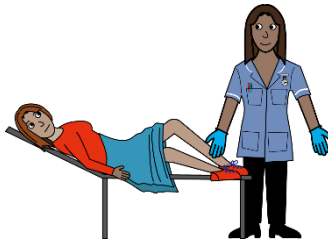


Dear

This test that looks for HPV (a virus) in your cervix. HPV can develop into cancer if you don't get it treated.

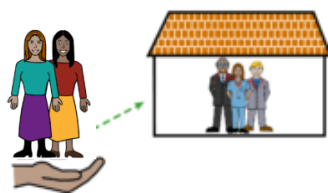


You can talk to the person doing the test and ask any questions you have. They will help you and talk you through the test.

**free of charge**

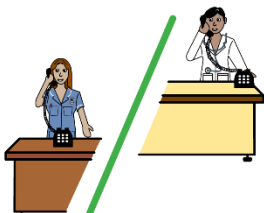


This is a normal routine test. It is free and helps save thousands of lives every year in the UK.

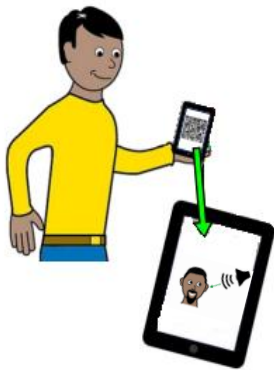
Please contact your GP practice to book in for a time that suits you and tell us about your reasonable adjustments.
